Most important points of our topic:

- need to address the waste of public money: appeals more to people
- make transparent that EU-infrastructure funding is inefficient, unfair, socially imbalanced and economically harmful

What do we want to achieve?

- Scandalise/emotionalise transport projects
- Awareness for waste of money
- Re-shift money from infrastructure/roads to other use (education, health, social aspects, lower taxes)
- Name and shame responsible people (politician, companies, lobbyist)
- Identify ppp as old idea, inappropriate for future challenges
- Make opportunity costs of new roads transparent.

Three possible strategies that are useful to achieve this:

- Point out overinvestment into roads and make opportunity costs transparent
- Name and shame
- Black book with bad examples for new infrastructure
- Find allies: finance policy, health, social aspects
- Fight ppp as old crap in new package

Further steps to succeed:

- Get the information about bad infrastructure
- Define clear objectives and messages for a campaign

• Raise money/find funding on all levels for a international coordinated campaign
